

How to connect a router to a fiber optic transceiver



Article Overview

To connect a fiber optic transceiver to a router, install the SFP module into the router's SFP slot, then connect the fiber optic cable to the module, and link the router to your network via the ONT or fiber infrastructure.

Step 1: Prepare Your Equipment

- SFP Transceiver Module: Choose the correct type (1G, 10G, single-mode, or multi-mode) compatible with your router and network requirements .
- Fiber Optic Cable: Ensure it matches the transceiver type (SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors are common), .
- Router with SFP Slot: Verify your router supports SFP modules.
- Static-Free Environment: Ground yourself using an anti-static wrist strap or touch a grounded metal surface to prevent damage .

Step 2: Install the SFP Module

- Power off the router to prevent electrical damage .
- Locate the SFP slot on the router, usually labeled "SFP" or "SFP+" .
- Align the SFP module with the slot, ensuring the metal connectors match the router's slot.
- Gently insert the module until it clicks into place. Avoid excessive force .

Step 3: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable

- Remove protective caps from both the fiber cable and the SFP module port
