

How to connect a router to the fiber optic cable in a room

To connect a router to a room using fiber optic cable, you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal, then link it to your router via Ethernet.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts the incoming fiber optic signal into an electrical signal your router can use, usually provided by your ISP .
- Fiber optic cable: Typically single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher): Connects the ONT to your router for high-speed data transfer .
- Router: Ensure it supports gigabit speeds or higher and has a WAN port for Ethernet input .

Step 2: Install the ONT

- Locate the fiber wall outlet where the ISP's fiber line enters the room .
- Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port, handling the connector carefully to avoid dirt or damage .
- Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, which may take a few minutes .

Step 3: Connect the ONT to the Router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN port
