

How to connect an ST fiber optic coupler



Article Overview

Connecting an ST fiber optic coupler involves careful preparation, alignment, and secure bayonet locking to ensure minimal signal loss.

Step 1: Prepare the Fiber Cable

- Strip the outer jacket of the fiber cable according to the connector specifications (typically 2mm or 3mm for ST connectors) using a fiber jacket stripper ().
- Remove the buffer coating to expose the bare fiber, taking care not to nick or damage the glass strand.
- Clean the fiber with isopropyl alcohol and lint-free wipes to remove any dust or oils ().

Step 2: Cleave and Polish the Fiber

- Cleave the fiber to a precise length using a fiber cleaver to ensure a flat, smooth end face ().
- Polish the fiber end using a polishing puck and appropriate polishing films (5 μ m for multimode, 0.05 μ m lapping film for singlemode) to achieve a smooth, perpendicular surface ().
- Inspect the fiber end under a microscope (200 $\times$ -400 $\times$ magnification) to confirm there are no scratches or debris ().

Step 3: Assemble the ST Connector

- Insert the polished fiber into the ST connector ferrule carefully, ensuring the fiber...
