

How to connect fiber optic cable to a splice box

Per-Splice Costs: Fusion splicing, which permanently connects two fibers, usually costs \$50–\$150 per splice. This includes labor and OTDR verification but generally excludes the splice box, trays, or project management fees. Larger fiber counts can reduce the per-splice rate due to volume pricing . **Materials:** A fiber optic splice box (closure) protects and organizes fiber connections. High-quality splice modules ensure minimal signal loss (less than 0.1 dB) and facilitate maintenance . **Material costs** for cables, conduits, and splice boxes typically range from \$1.50 to \$2.00 per foot for standard single-mode fiber . **Labor and Installation:** Labor costs depend on route complexity, access method, and terrain. For example, a mid-length urban route may require 120 hours at \$120/hour, including trenching, conduit installation, and splicing . Underground installations are more expensive than aerial deployments due to excavation and restoration work . **Total Project Costs:** For a typical urban installation with multiple splices, testing, certification, and permits, total costs can range from \$60,000 to \$110,000. Factors influencing the final price include fiber type (single-mode vs. multi-mode), route length, number of splices, and regional labor rates
