This makes MMF ideal for short- to medium-distance applications such as LANs, data centers, and enterprise networks . Common types include OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, and OM5, each with different core sizes, bandwidths, and maximum transmission distances .

Choosing the Right Connector

The most common connectors for multimode fiber are:

- LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor, widely used in high-density applications.
- SC (Subscriber Connector): Push-pull design, easy to install.
- ST (Straight Tip): Bayonet-style, often used in legacy networks.
- MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors for high-speed, high-density links . Ensure the connector type matches the equipment and fiber type. For example, OM3 and OM4 fibers are optimized for VCSEL laser sources, while OM1 and OM2 typically use LED sources ...
