

How to connect network cables and fiber optic cables with cold connectors

Cold connectors, also known as mechanical or field-terminated connectors, allow quick, tool-assisted connections without fusion splicing or epoxy, suitable for both fiber optic and network cables.

Fiber Optic Cold Connectors

Definition and Purpose: Cold connectors, or fast connectors, are mechanical splicing devices that join optical fibers without the need for heat or epoxy. They are pre-polished and factory-prepared, allowing rapid field termination while maintaining low signal loss (typically 0.1–0.3 dB per point) and reasonable mechanical strength.

Installation Process:

- **Prepare the fiber:** Strip the outer sheath and protective coating using a fiber stripper, exposing the bare fiber.
- **Cleave the fiber:** Use a calibrated fiber cleaver to create a smooth, even end face for optimal light transmission.
- **Insert into connector:** Place the fiber into the mechanical splice inside the connector, aligning it with the pre-installed V-groove and clamping mechanism.
- **Lock the fiber:** Press the gland or wedge clip to secure the fiber in place.
- **Finish assembly:** Slide the connector boot over the termination to protect the joint.
- **Test the connection:** Use an optical power meter or visual fault locator to verify signal integrity.

Precautions:

- Keep connectors and fibers clean to avoid contamination
