

How to connect the electrical box and distribution box

Connecting an electrical box to a distribution box involves safely linking the main power supply to the distribution board, installing circuit breakers, and wiring outgoing circuits according to load requirements.

Step 1: Safety First

Before starting, turn off the main power supply to prevent electrical shock. Ensure you have insulated tools, gloves, and a multimeter to verify connections .

Step 2: Mount the Distribution Box

Secure the distribution box to a wall at an accessible height. Make sure the installation site is free of obstructions and moisture .

Step 3: Connect the Incoming Power

- Identify the incoming live (phase) wire (usually brown or red) and the neutral wire (blue or black).
- Connect the live wire to the main terminal or main MCB in the distribution box.
- Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar.
- If required, connect the earth wire to the grounding bar for safety .
