

How to connect the fiber optic patch cord to the network box

4. Insert the Connector Gently align the connector with the port and push it in until you hear or feel a click, indicating it is securely seated. Do not force the connector, as this can damage both the fiber and the port .
5. Manage the Cable Route the patch cord neatly using cable trays, Velcro ties, or cable rings. Avoid sharp bends, kinks, or crossing over other cables. Coil any extra length on a spool or inner tray without obstructing other connections .
6. Label the Connection Label both ends of the patch cord to indicate the source and destination ports. Proper labeling ensures easy troubleshooting and future network upgrades .
7. Test the Connection After installation, verify the connection using a vi...
