

How to connect the optical port of a gigabit mini switch

To connect the optical (SFP) port of a gigabit mini switch, insert a compatible SFP module into the port, then connect the fiber optic cable, ensuring proper orientation, secure seating, and cleanliness.

Step-by-Step Connection Guide

1. Power Off the Switch Before handling the SFP port, turn off the switch to prevent electrical or optical damage and reduce the risk of link errors . 2. Prepare the SFP Module

- Identify the correct SFP module type: optical (fiber) or electrical (copper) depending on your network setup .
- Hold the module by the sides or metal cage; avoid touching the gold contacts or optical bore .
- Keep dust caps on until ready to insert. 3. Insert the SFP Module
- Remove the protective cover from the SFP port.
- Align the module's key (a small groove or ridge) with the port's keyway.
- Slide the module straight into the port until it clicks or seats firmly. Some modules may have a latch or screw to secure them .
- Do not force, twist, or rock the module; if resistance occurs, check orientation and port cleanliness. 4. Connect the Fiber Optic Cable
- Remove dust caps from both the SFP module and fiber connector.
- Clean the fiber end-face with a lint-free wipe and isopropyl alcohol....
