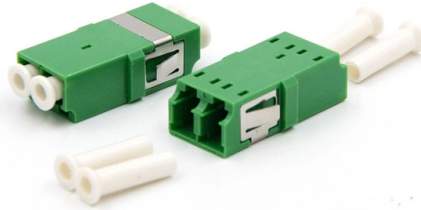


How to connect the pigtail terminal



Overview

Wiring a pigtail involves stripping the ends of your hot, neutral, or ground wires, twisting them together with a lead wire using a UL-listed wire nut, and securing that single lead to the outlet or switch. The technique known as pigtail involves using short lengths of wire to bridge the main circuit conductors and the device terminals, isolating the receptacle from the continuous circuit path. This pigtail technique is applicable in several home and automotive wiring projects, especially for circuit grounding wires.
