

How to connect two pigtails to one pigtail

To connect two pigtail wires into one, strip the ends, twist them together, and secure with a wire connector or crimp, ensuring a safe and solid electrical connection.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Safety First Before starting, turn off the power at the breaker or disconnect the battery if working on a vehicle. Verify the circuit is de-energized using a voltage tester and wear eye protection . 2. Prepare the Wires

- Strip about 1/2 to 3/4 inch of insulation from the ends of each pigtail wire .
- Ensure the wires are of the same gauge and insulation type as the circuit to maintain safety and conductivity . 3. Join the Wires
- Align the stripped ends so the copper conductors meet.
- Twist the wires together clockwise using pliers or by hand. For twist-on wire connectors, pre-twisting may not be necessary if the connector instructions allow . 4.

Secure the Connection

- Use a wire nut, crimp connector, or lever-type connector to secure the twisted wires.
- Make sure the connector fully covers the exposed copper and holds the wires tightly . 5. Add a Single Lead (Optional)
- If connecting to a device terminal, add a short pigtail lead from the splice to the terminal. This allows multiple wires to connect to a single screw without crowding . 6.

Inspect and Test

- Ensure no bare copper is exposed outside the connector.
- Restore power and test the circuit to confirm proper connectivity....
