

How to cut elbows in cable tray covers



Overview

Cable tray cutting will be made using a hand held hack saw or jigsaw machine. It is important to get a square cut to ensure a good splice connection. Creating a 90-degree elbow in an electrical cable tray, often called a "fabricated" or "mitered" bend, involves cutting, bending, and fastening a straight section of tray. To avoid transverse bending at higher loads, a joint plate must be used for tray widths of 400 mm or more in the joint area of the cable trays that are to be connected.
