

How to directly connect the wire to the distribution box



Article Overview

To connect a wire to a distribution box safely, first turn off the main power, then attach the incoming live wire to the main terminal, connect circuit breakers, and wire outgoing circuits according to load requirements.

Step-by-Step Connection Process

- Turn Off Main Power Always ensure the main power supply is switched off before starting any work to prevent electrical shock or accidents .
- Secure the Distribution Box Mount the box on a dry, ventilated wall at an accessible height (typically around 1.5 meters). Ensure the installation site is free from obstructions and away from flammable or corrosive materials .
- Connect the Incoming Wire
- Identify the live (phase) wire (usually brown or red) and the neutral wire (blue or black).
- Attach the live wire to the main terminal or main MCB. For single-phase systems, a double-pole MCB is commonly used as the main switch .
- Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar and the earth wire to the earthing terminal .
- Install Circuit Breakers
- Place single-pole MCBs for individual circuits in their designated slots.
- For special loads, double-pole MCBs may be used.
- Connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB (if used), and then connect the output of the RCCB to the individual MCBs
