

How to handle cable bends when laying cables in cable trays

Key Practices for Bending Cable Trays

Maintain Minimum Bending Radius: Each cable type has a specified minimum bending radius, which must be observed to prevent insulation damage or conductor stress. Exceeding this radius can lead to overheating or premature failure of the cable . **Use Rollers or Pulleys:** For horizontal or vertical bends, install rollers or pulleys to guide the cables smoothly through the bend. Ensure the rollers are of sufficient diameter to avoid pinching the cable between flanges and to maintain the minimum bending radius . **Organize and Secure Cables:** Lay cables in an orderly manner, avoiding overlapping or twisting. Secure them at regular intervals using cable ties or clamps to prevent sagging, which is especially important at bends where cables may naturally shift . **Plan the Layout:** Before installation, inspect the tray path for obstacles and ensure the bend angles are gradual. Sharp or abrupt bends should be avoided; if unavoidable, consider using prefabricated bend sections or radius elbows designed for the tray system . **Consider Cable Load and Tray Size:** Ensure the tray can accommodate the number and size of cables without overcrowding, particularly at bends where space is limited. Overcrowding can increase heat buildup and reduce cable life . **Check for Debris and Smooth Surfaces:** Ensure the tray surfaces at bends are free of sharp edges or debris that could damage the cable insulation during inst...
