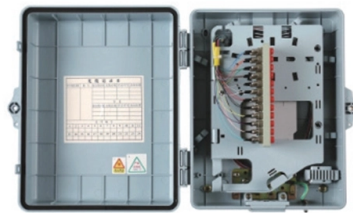


How to install fiber optic cables in the ground

Installation Methods
