

How to install the nails on the cable tray support



Article Overview

Cable tray supports should be secured using appropriate anchors, brackets, or threaded rods rather than simple nails to ensure safety and compliance with electrical codes.

Choosing the Right Fastener

For cable tray supports, nails are generally not recommended because they do not provide sufficient load-bearing strength. Instead, use:

- Expansion bolts or drop-in anchors for concrete walls or ceilings
- Threaded rods with Unistrut channels for ceiling suspensions (trapeze hangers)
- Cantilever brackets for wall-mounted trays These fasteners ensure the tray can safely support the weight of cables over time and comply with NEC Article 392 requirements .

Step-by-Step Installation

- Mark Support Points: Use a chalk line or laser level to mark where supports will be installed. Standard spacing is typically 1.5 to 2 meters depending on tray type and load .
- Drill Holes: For concrete, use a hammer drill to create holes for anchors. For steel structures, use appropriate metal fasteners .
- Insert Anchors: Place expansion bolts or drop-in anchors into the drilled holes. Ensure they are flush and secure
