

How to install the wiring for the distribution box

Proper wiring of a distribution box involves securely connecting input and output wires to breakers and terminals, ensuring correct phase, neutral, and earth connections, and testing for safety before powering on.

Preparation and Safety

Before starting, turn off the main power supply to prevent electrical shock. Gather necessary tools such as wire strippers, screwdrivers, a multimeter, zip ties, and appropriate wire gauges. Choose a distribution box suitable for your environment (indoor/outdoor) and load requirements, ensuring it has the correct IP/NEMA rating and is made of durable material like steel or plastic .

Mounting the Box

Fix the distribution box securely to a wall or mounting surface at an accessible height (typically around 1.5 meters). Ensure it is level, stable, and free from obstructions. For outdoor installations, use a waterproof box and add a rain cover to prevent water ingress .

Wiring Steps

- Identify Input and Output Wires: Determine the incoming live (phase), neutral, and earth wires from the main supply and the outgoing wires for each circuit .
- Connect the Main Supply: Attach the incoming live wire to the main MCB terminal,...
