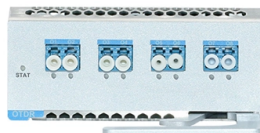


How to label optical cables



Article Overview

Labeling optical cables requires clear identifiers, durable materials, and proper placement to ensure long-term readability and network efficiency.

Key Components of a Cable Label

- Cable Identifier: Use a unique alphanumeric code to differentiate each cable, e.g., "FB-03-A142," where "FB" indicates fiber, "03" the zone or floor, and "A142" the specific cable number .
- Source and Destination: Clearly indicate where the cable begins and ends, e.g., "Server Rack 12A to IDF-3" .
- Cable Specifications: Include type (single-mode or multimode), fiber count (12-strand, 24-strand), and designations like OM3 or OM4 .
- Installation Date: Helps track cable age and maintenance schedules, e.g., "Inst: 03/2024" .

Label Types and Materials

- Thermal Transfer Labels: Ideal for indoor installations; resistant to temperature changes, handling, and fading, lasting over 10 years .
- Heat-Shrink Tubing Labels: Best for outdoor or industrial environments; permanently adheres to the cable and resists UV and scratching .
- Wrap-Around Flags: Flexible for frequently moved cables; easy to install without disconnecting, but may loosen over time .
- High-Resolution Printed Labels: Laser or thermal printing ensures legibility in dense cable bundles
