

How to lay cables on cable trays in conduits

Properly laying cable conduits in cable trays requires careful planning, correct tray selection, organized cable placement, and adherence to safety and electrical standards.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, plan the cable tray route according to the electrical design and site layout, considering clearance, load capacity, and separation of different voltage or signal cables (). Verify that all materials, including trays, conduits, and accessories, are approved and free from damage (). Inspect the site to ensure it is safe, accessible, and coordinated with other trades to prevent interference ().

Selecting and Installing Cable Trays

Choose the appropriate tray type based on cable type and environment:

- Ladder trays: Ideal for power cables, allow airflow, and easy cable entry.
- Ventilated troughs: Provide continuous support for smaller control or instrumentation cables.
- Solid-bottom trays: Suitable for environments requiring extra protection (). Secure trays using proper clamps and brackets, spaced according to tray type and load (typically 1.5–3 meters apart). Ensure trays are level, straight, and aligned, using connectors and fittings for long runs ()....
