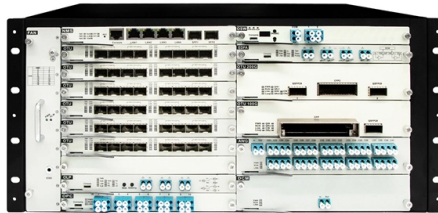


How to maintain optical cables

Proper maintenance of optical cables involves regular cleaning, careful handling, environmental monitoring, and periodic testing to ensure optimal signal performance and longevity.

Cleaning and Handling

Maintaining clean optical connectors is critical, as dust, oil, and other contaminants can degrade signal quality or damage fiber ends. Always avoid touching the fiber end face and never allow it to contact surfaces or fingers. Use lint-free wipes, fiber optic cleaning pens, and spectroscopic-grade isopropyl alcohol or methanol for cleaning connectors and end faces. Ensure the device is powered off and other light sources are disabled during cleaning to prevent eye injury from laser radiation. Avoid bending cables beyond their minimum bend radius to prevent micro-bending losses or fiber breakage .

Inspection and Testing

Regular inspections help detect early signs of wear or damage. Monthly checks should include visual inspection of connectors, testing backbone link attenuation, and cleaning end faces. Quarterly or semi-annual maintenance may involve OTDR (Optical Time Domain Reflectometer) testing, reviewing system alarms, and updating maintenance logs. These practices help identify potential issues before they cause network failures .
