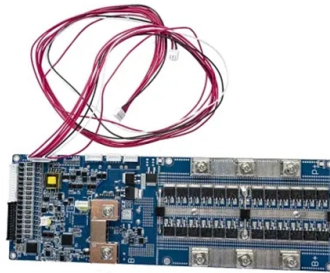


How to match circuit breakers in a distribution box

To match a circuit breaker to a distribution box, select a breaker type and rating that corresponds to the load, wire size, and protection requirements of each circuit while ensuring compatibility with the box's layout and standards.

Understand the Distribution Box

A distribution box, also called a consumer unit or load center, receives incoming power and distributes it to multiple circuits through protective devices like MCBs, RCDs, or RCBOs. Key components include the main breaker or isolator, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and branch circuit breakers. Proper coordination ensures safety, overload protection, and organized power distribution ().

Determine Circuit Requirements

- Identify each circuit: Determine which areas or equipment each circuit will serve, such as lighting, outlets, or high-power appliances ().
- Calculate load: Sum the expected amperage for each circuit, considering resistive, inductive, and capacitive loads. Apply safety margins to prevent overloads ().
- Check wire size: Ensure the wire gauge matches the breaker rating to prevent overheating. For example, a 16A breaker typically requires 1.5–2.5 mm² wire, while a 32A breaker may need 4 mm² or larger ().
