

How to melt a soft-hearted optical cable

To melt or fuse a fiber optic cable, use a fusion splicer to join the fiber ends after proper preparation, ensuring a strong and reliable connection.

Equipment Needed

- **Fusion Splicer:** A specialized device that uses heat to melt and join fiber ends precisely .
- **Fiber Strippers:** To remove the protective coating and expose the glass core .
- **Fiber Cleaver:** Creates a clean, flat end on the fiber for accurate alignment .
- **Alcohol Wipes:** For cleaning the fiber before splicing to remove dust or debris .
- **Safety Glasses:** Protect your eyes from flying fibers or debris .

Step-by-Step Process

- **Inspect the Cable:** Check for any damage, kinks, or exposed fibers to ensure the cable is in good condition .
- **Strip the Jacket and Buffer:** Use fiber strippers to remove the outer jacket and buffer tubes carefully, exposing the fiber core without damaging it .
- **Cleave the Fiber:** Use a fiber cleaver to create a flat, precise end on each fiber. Proper cleaving is critical for a strong fusion splice .
- **Clean the Fiber Ends:** Wipe the cleaved fiber ends with alcohol to remove any contaminants .
- **Fusion Splicing:** Place the prepared fibers into the fusion splicer. The device will align the fibers and apply heat to melt and fuse them together, forming a continuous optical path .
