

How to run thick cables inside cable trays



Article Overview

Running thick cables through cable trays requires careful planning of tray type, fill capacity, bend radius, and support spacing to ensure safety, code compliance, and ease of maintenance.

Select the Appropriate Cable Tray Type

For thick or large-diameter cables, ladder trays are generally preferred because their open design allows better ventilation and easier handling of heavy cables. Ladder trays consist of two side rails connected by rungs, providing anchor points for securing cables and minimizing sag. Ventilated trough trays can also be used if additional support is needed, but they may limit airflow and require stricter fill calculations. Solid-bottom trays are less suitable for thick cables due to heat buildup and limited accessibility.

Calculate Tray Fill and Load

Before installation, determine the maximum fill capacity according to NEC Article 392 or local codes. Overfilling can cause overheating, make maintenance difficult, and compromise safety. For thick cables, ensure the tray width and depth accommodate the cable bundle without exceeding the recommended fill percentage. Use bundling and spacing techniques to distribute weight evenly and prevent cable deformation.

Maintain Proper Bend Radius

Thick cables have a minimum bend radius that must be respected to avoid insulatio...
