Understand the Purpose

A secondary distribution box distributes electrical power from a transformer or main supply to downstream circuits, ensuring protection and control for end-users in residential, commercial, or industrial settings . It typically houses circuit breakers, fuses, and sometimes control devices, safeguarding equipment and personnel.

Key Selection Criteria

1. Load and Capacity

- Determine the total connected load and future expansion needs.
 - Choose a box rated for the maximum current expected, considering both continuous and peak loads.
 - For high-reliability applications, consider secondary selective service or spot network configurations to maintain power during faults .
- #### 2. Voltage and Phase
- Verify the secondary voltage (commonly 208, 240, 480, or 600 V) and whether a single-phase or three-phase system is required .
 - Ensure compatibility with the upstream transformer and downstream equipment....
