

How to set up a secondary power distribution box on site

A secondary power distribution box, or sub-panel, can be safely installed by selecting the right enclosure, connecting a dedicated feeder from the main panel, organizing branch circuits, and following proper grounding and safety standards.

Step 1: Planning and Location

Choose a suitable location for the distribution box that is dry, accessible, and well-ventilated. For residential setups, a height of around 1.5 meters is recommended, while industrial installations may vary depending on surrounding equipment and space. Ensure the site is away from water, flammable, or corrosive substances, and leave enough clearance for maintenance and future expansion. If outdoors, select an enclosure with a high IP or NEMA rating (e.g., IP66 or NEMA 4) to protect against dust and moisture.

Step 2: Selecting the Distribution Box

Choose a box based on load capacity, environment, and durability. Industrial boxes are designed for high-capacity use, while residential boxes handle lighter loads. Ensure the box includes circuit breakers, busbars, terminal blocks, and DIN rails for mounting additional devices. Use UL or CE-certified components to comply with safety standards.
