

How to tie fiber optic cables to power poles



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables can be safely installed on power poles using aerial deployment techniques, typically with ADSS cables that are self-supporting and non-conductive, following strict safety and regulatory standards.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, survey the route to identify pole locations, obstacles, and environmental conditions. Obtain all necessary permits from local authorities and coordinate with utility companies if sharing poles with power lines. Determine splice points, slack storage, and service loops in advance to ensure proper cable management during and after installation .

Choosing the Right Cable

For deployment near power lines, use All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) cables, which are non-conductive and designed to withstand electrical fields, wind, ice, and animal damage. ADSS cables contain glass-reinforced plastic or aramid fibers for tensile strength instead of metal, making them safe for installation in the power space . Lightweight and flexible cables reduce strain on poles and simplify installation.
