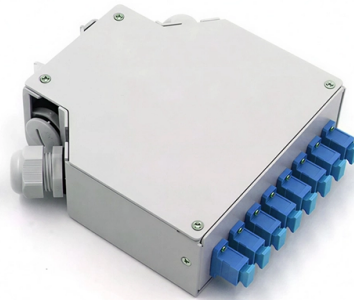


How to use an industrial-grade switch at home

You can operate an industrial-grade switch at home by ensuring proper power supply, secure mounting, and careful network configuration while respecting its industrial design requirements.

Power and Physical Setup

Industrial switches often require DC power inputs ranging from 12V to 58V and may support dual power supplies for redundancy . Ensure you use a compatible power adapter and verify polarity before connecting. Unlike consumer switches, these devices are designed for DIN rail or panel mounting inside control cabinets to resist vibration and dust . At home, you can place the switch on a stable, ventilated surface or inside a small enclosure to protect it from dust and accidental knocks.

Network Connection

Connect your computer to the switch using either the management Ethernet port or the Console port with the supplied RJ45-to-DB9 cable . This allows you to access the switch's configuration interface. Use the default IP address, username, and password provided in the manual, or update them for security .
