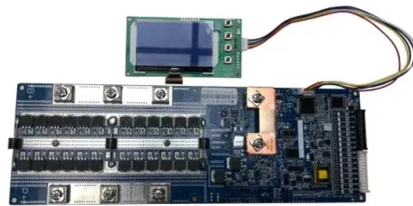


How to wire the high-voltage distribution box for plate heat exchangers

Wiring a high-voltage distribution box for plate heat exchangers requires careful planning, adherence to electrical codes, and proper connection of protective devices, motors, and control circuits.

Key Considerations

Ensure proper phase sequence and verify voltage ratings match the equipment requirements. 4. **Motor and Pump Wiring** Plate heat exchangers often use circulation pumps.
