Fault Detection and Monitoring

Protective relays continuously monitor electrical quantities such as current, voltage, frequency, and phase angle to detect abnormal conditions like overcurrent, short circuits, under-voltage, or frequency deviations . They identify the presence, type, and location of faults before significant damage occurs, ensuring timely intervention .

Trip Initiation and Fault Isolation

Once a fault is detected, the relay sends a trip signal to circuit breakers or other interrupting devices to isolate the affected section . This rapid disconnection prevents the fault from spreading, limits damage, and maintains operational continuity in the rest of the system .

Equipment Protection

Relays safeguard critical electrical equipment such as transformers, generators, motors, and transmission lines from damage caused by abnormal operating conditions . By quickly removing faulted components, relays reduce thermal and mechanical stress on equipment, extending its lifespan and reliability .
