Overview

The incoming cable head is the point where the main supply cable enters the distribution box. It is typically connected to screw terminals, busbars, or an incoming device such as a switch disconnecter, MCCB, or MCB, depending on the box design and load requirements. This connection ensures that power is safely distributed to all outgoing circuits while allowing for protection and isolation.

Cable Requirements

- **Cable Size:** The maximum size of incoming conductors varies by box type. Single-phase boxes may accept up to 120 mm², while three-phase boxes can also handle up to 120 mm² for the main supply.
- **Connection Type:** Incoming cables are usually connected to shrouded terminals to prevent accidental contact and ensure good electrical and mechanical contact.
- **Fuse or Breaker Protection:** An external fuse or circuit breaker is often required before the distribution box to protect the incoming cable and the system.
