Purpose of Multi-Level Distribution

Using multiple levels also allows for localized control, making troubleshooting and emergency isolation more manageable .

Levels of Distribution Boxes

- First-Level (Primary) Distribution
 - Handles high-voltage input from the utility or main transformer.
 - Contains isolation switches, circuit breakers, and leakage protectors.
 - Does not directly supply end-use equipment; it serves as the main hub for power routing .
- Second-Level (Secondary) Distribution
 - Supplies three-phase power to major industrial equipment like motors, HVAC systems, or production lines.
 - Equipped with large three-phase circuit breakers to protect high-power loads.
 - Often designed for modular expansion to accommodate future load growth
