Overview

A distribution box, also known as a DB box, distribution board, or electrical panel, is a centralized unit that receives electrical power from the main supply and distributes it to various circuits within a building or facility . It acts as the heart of the electrical system, ensuring safe, organized, and efficient power flow while protecting circuits from overloads, short circuits, and other electrical faults .

Internal Components

The inner panel of a distribution box typically contains the following key components:

- **Circuit Breakers and Fuses:** These provide protection by interrupting the flow of electricity in case of overloads or short circuits .
- **Busbars:** Conductive metal strips, usually made of copper or aluminum, that distribute power from the main input to individual circuits .
- **Main Switch:** Controls the overall power supply to the distribution box.
- **Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or RCBOs:** Protect against earth faults and overcurrent, enhancing safety .
- **Indication Lights:** Show the status of the mains power supply and operational conditions
