

Installation of Distribution Box Conversion Bracket

Installing a distribution box conversion bracket involves securely mounting the bracket, aligning it with the existing unit, and ensuring proper sealing and electrical connections for safe and reliable operation.

Step-by-Step Installation

1. Prepare the Site and Components Before installation, verify that the mounting surface can support the weight of the distribution box and bracket. Check for proper clearance, ventilation, and compliance with local electrical standards. Ensure all components, including the conversion bracket, screws, and adapters, are available and compatible with your existing distribution box or rooftop unit .
2. Mount the Conversion Bracket Attach the conversion bracket to the bottom of the rooftop unit or distribution box using the provided bolts. Align the bracket carefully to ensure stability and proper fit. For rooftop units, the recommended roof thickness is 3–6 inches (75–152 mm), . For indoor or industrial distribution boxes, use appropriate anchors for the substrate, such as chemical anchors for concrete or heavy-duty toggle anchors for hollow walls .
3. Replace or Adjust Existing Brackets and Dividers If the installation involves retrofitting, remove any existing metal brackets or duct dividers. Install the new bracket and ensure all gaps are sealed with aluminum foil tape or other suitable sealing materials to maintain airflow and prevent dust or moisture ingress .
4. Electrical Connections If connecting to a different brand of Air Distribution Box (ADB), use the wire adapter provided in the conversion bracket kit. Ensure all wiring follows manufacturer specifications and local electrical codes. Arra...
