

Installation of Dutch Tray Cable Trays



Article Overview

Dutch tray cable trays should be installed with careful planning, proper support, and adherence to material and code requirements to ensure safe, durable, and organized cable management.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, review the approved shop drawings to determine the layout, length, and location of the Dutch trays in the building or facility . Inspect all materials upon delivery to ensure they match the approved specifications and are free from damage . Store trays horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports at intervals of about one meter, protecting them from moisture and sunlight .

Material Selection

Dutch trays are available in light-duty tray designs with continuous longitudinal slot perforations, suitable for industrial, marine, and machine-building applications . They can be made from steel, aluminum, or fiberglass-reinforced polyester (FRP) depending on environmental conditions, with FRP offering corrosion resistance and non-conductivity for high-moisture or chemical environments . Covers can be added for full enclosure, using lid clamps or fasteners to protect cables from dust and mechanical damage .
