Overview of Cable Tray Systems

Metal cable trays, including ladder, solid bottom, trough, channel, wire mesh, and single rail types, are used to support and route electrical cables safely across open spans. They are typically made from steel, aluminum, or fiber-reinforced plastic, with steel and aluminum being the most common for industrial applications due to their strength and corrosion resistance (). Cable trays are installed on ceilings, walls, or floors and must withstand mechanical loads, environmental conditions, and comply with standards such as NEMA VE1, FG1, VE2, and the National Electrical Code (NEC) ().

Selecting Metal Fixing Fittings

Metal fixing fittings include connectors, brackets, clamps, and support elements that secure cable trays to structural supports. Selection depends on:

- Tray type and material (e.g., steel vs. aluminum)
- Load requirements (weight of cables and environmental factors)
- Mounting surface (concrete, steel beams, or walls)
- Corrosion protection (galvanized, stainless steel, or coated finishes) ()....
