

Installation of Special Optical Cable Splice Box

Proper installation of optical cable splice boxes requires careful cable preparation, secure sealing, strain relief, controlled fiber routing, and environmental protection to ensure long-term network performance.

Cable Preparation

Before installing a splice box, the optical cable must be prepared carefully. This involves removing the outer jacket, shielding, and armor to expose the loose tubes, leaving sufficient length (typically around 3 meters) for splicing and routing. The exposed fibers should be cleaned and abraded to remove excess filling and ensure a smooth surface for sealing. Proper preparation prevents contamination and mechanical stress that could degrade signal quality.

Splice Box Installation

- **Sealing and Entry:** Select sealing rings that match the cable diameter and place them on the cable. Insert the cable into the designated entry port of the splice box, ensuring a tight seal with self-adhesive tape or gaskets.
- **Grounding:** Connect and ground any metallic shielding to prevent electrical interference.
- **Strain Relief:** Secure the cable to the closure base using clamps or brackets to absorb mechanical stress and prevent tension from transferring to the fiber splices.
