Proper installation of a three-level distribution box ensures safe, efficient, and compliant power distribution for multi-story heating systems.

Planning and Placement

- **Location:** Install the distribution box in a dry, accessible area with good ventilation, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters for easy access and maintenance .
- **Environment:** Ensure the box has an appropriate IP or NEMA rating to protect against dust, moisture, and mechanical damage, especially if installed near heating equipment or in industrial settings .
- **Load Assessment:** Calculate the total electrical load for all three levels, including heating pumps, valves, and control units, to select the correct breaker ratings and wire sizes .

Wiring and Connections

- **Three-Phase Supply:** Connect the incoming three-phase power (R, Y, B) from the main energy meter to the MCCB (Moulded Case Circuit Breaker) as the main switch .
- **Neutral and Grounding:** Use a separate neutral bus and ensure proper grounding to prevent electrical hazards .
- **Sub-Distribution:** Each level should have its own sub-distribution board with breakers sized according to the load of that floor, including heating circuits, pumps, and auxiliary devices
