Main switches are rated for the maximum current capacity of the system and are essential for protecting the entire electrical network from overloads or faults .

Isolators

Isolators are manually operated switches used to safely disconnect a portion of the circuit for maintenance or repair. They are typically installed alongside miniature circuit breakers (MCBs) and allow electricians to work without risk of electric shock. Isolators do not trip automatically; they must be operated manually .

Circuit Breakers

Circuit breakers are automatic switches that protect individual circuits from overcurrent or short circuits. When excessive current flows, the breaker trips, interr...
