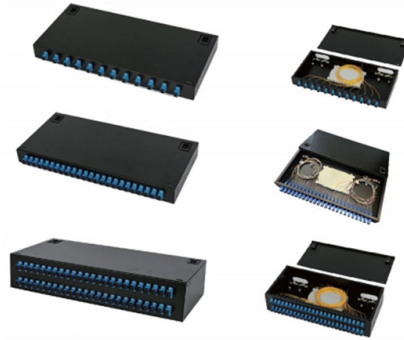


Is F-type cable tray a fireproof cable tray

Understanding F-Type Cable Trays

F-type cable trays are classified according to fire endurance standards, commonly using grades F1 through F4. These grades indicate the duration a cable tray system can maintain structural and circuit integrity under fire conditions. For example, an F3-rated tray is designed to withstand fire for at least 45 minutes, ensuring that the cables inside remain operational and the tray structure does not collapse .

Fireproofing Requirements

To achieve fireproof performance, an F-type cable tray must often be fully enclosed with a cover plate and integrated with fireproof sealing. This creates a complete fire-resistant system that protects the cables from direct flame, heat, and smoke penetration . Simply being labeled as F-type does not automatically make the tray fireproof; the tray must meet the relevant fire resistance standards such as GB 29415-2013 in China or equivalent international standards .

- **Material:** Steel, aluminum, PVC, and FRP/GRP trays have different thermal properties, affecting fire performance .
- **Circuit Integrity:** Fireproof trays are tested to ensure the cable loop remains unint...
