

Ladder-type cable tray maintenance

Regular inspection, cleaning, and timely repair are key to maintaining ladder-type cable trays and ensuring safe, long-lasting cable support.

Inspection and Visual Checks

Routine inspections are essential to identify potential issues early. Check all joints, fastenings, and supports visually to ensure they are secure and properly fixed. Look for dirt, debris, or foreign objects that may obstruct airflow or damage cables. Any loose or damaged components should be tightened or repaired according to manufacturer recommendations. For FRP ladder trays, inspect for broken welds, deformed side rails, or bent rungs, and repair or replace as necessary .

Cleaning and Surface Maintenance

Use a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and dirt from the tray surface regularly. Avoid wet cloths, abrasive tools, or contact with acidic, alkaline, or greasy substances, as these can damage the tray surface. For metallic trays, a small amount of machine oil can be applied to hardware fittings to prevent rust and maintain flexibility. For enhanced protection, specialized polishing wax can be applied quarterly to maintain shine and provide moisture resistance .

Cable Management

Remove unused or dead cables to maintain proper loading capacity and ventilation. Ensure cables are evenly distributed along the rungs to prevent sagging and overheating.
