This anti-catalytic property is critical in tropical or humid climates, such as Laos, where high moisture, temperature fluctuations, and potential exposure to pollutants could otherwise accelerate corrosion or fiber degradation. Materials commonly used include high-grade plastics (ABS+PC) or sturdy metals with protective coatings, which resist water, dust, and chemical exposure.

Design Considerations

The anti-catalytic effect is enhanced by several design features:

- Insulation between metal components and the box shell prevents galvanic reactions that could damage fibers.
- Sealed enclosures with IP65 or IP68 ratings protect against water ingress and dust, reducing the risk of chemical reactions on fiber surfaces.
- Ventilation and moisture control prevent condensation, which could otherwise cat...
