

Laying wire mesh on trapezoidal cable trays



Article Overview

Wire mesh can be effectively installed on trapezoidal cable trays by carefully planning support placement, cutting and shaping the mesh to fit the tray profile, and securing it with appropriate fasteners.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, map the cable routes and determine the load of cables to ensure the trapezoidal tray can support them safely. Allocate sufficient clearance for maintenance and future cable additions, and identify the points where supports will be installed, typically every 1.5 to 2 meters depending on tray weight and cable load.

Cutting and Shaping the Mesh

Wire mesh trays are flexible and can be cut or bent to match the trapezoidal profile. Use bolt cutters or a tray cutter to size the mesh, and smooth sharp edges with a file to prevent cable damage. For bends or angled sections, either manually shape the mesh or use prefabricated bends to maintain a clean installation. Ensure the mesh conforms to the trapezoidal shape without leaving gaps that could compromise cable support.
