Layouts should separate different voltage systems to prevent interference and ensure safety . **Protection Devices:** Incorporate appropriate protection based on fault risks, including short circuits, overcurrent, and arc faults. Use circuit breakers, fuses, and switchgear assemblies with suitable ratings and selectivity to isolate faults without affecting the entire system . **Component Placement and Accessibility:** Ensure distribution boxes are easily accessible for maintenance and emergency response. Avoid placing panels near noisy, hot, or corrosive environments.
