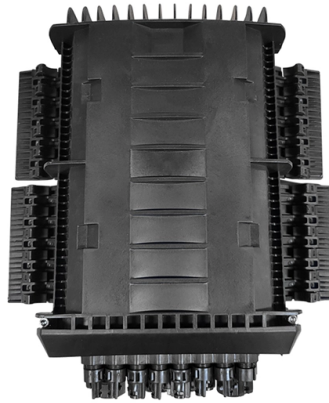


Level 3 Factory Building Distribution Box

A Level 3 distribution box is a tertiary electrical distribution unit that delivers mains electricity (typically 220V) directly to individual units or equipment within a factory, providing single-phase circuit protection and control.

Overview

A Level 3 distribution box is the final stage in a three-level power distribution system used in industrial or construction environments. It receives power from a secondary distribution box (Level 2) and distributes it to specific machinery, equipment, or workstations within a factory building. Unlike Level 1 and Level 2 boxes, which handle higher voltages and three-phase power, Level 3 boxes typically provide single-phase mains electricity suitable for direct use by electrical devices and equipment.

Structure and Components

Level 3 distribution boxes are designed to ensure safety, control, and protection for end-use electrical circuits. Key components include:

- Single-phase circuit breakers for overload and short-circuit protection.
- Leakage protection devices to prevent electric shock.
- Terminal blocks and connectors for organized wiring.
- Enclosures that are often rainproof or IP-rated for factory environments, ensuring durability and safety in harsh conditions. The design follows the principle of “one machine, one switch, one protection, one box, one lock”, meaning each electrical device is controlled and protected individually to prevent overloading or unsafe operation.
