Construction and Materials

- **Conductors:** Typically made of high-conductivity copper, either solid or stranded, to ensure efficient signal transmission and flexibility for installation .
- **Insulation:** Commonly PVC (Polyvinyl Chloride) or XLPE (Cross-Linked Polyethylene), providing electrical insulation, mechanical protection, and resistance to heat and UV exposure .
- **Sheathing:** Outer sheaths are often PVC or UV-stable materials, sometimes with additional shielding for electromagnetic interference (EMI) protection .
- **Cores:** Can be single-core or multi-core, twisted or untwisted, depending on the application. Twisted pairs are common in data and network cables to reduce crosstalk
