

Making a cable tray fixing bracket



Article Overview

Cable tray brackets are fabricated from steel or stainless steel and installed using a combination of support elements, mounting plates, and fasteners to securely hold cable trays on walls, ceilings, or floors.

Materials and Design

Cable tray brackets are typically made from steel or stainless steel, often with galvanization or other corrosion-resistant coatings to withstand environmental conditions . The design must accommodate the weight of the cable tray and cables, and allow for horizontal or vertical adjustments. Brackets can be wall-mounted, floor-mounted, or suspended from ceilings depending on the installation requirements .

Fabrication Steps

- **Cutting and Shaping:** Steel sheets or bars are cut to the required dimensions. Brackets are bent or welded to form the support shape, ensuring proper angles for tray alignment.
- **Drilling Holes:** Pre-drilled holes are made for mounting bolts or screws to attach the bracket to the structure and to the cable tray .
- **Surface Treatment:** Apply galvanization, powder coating, or other corrosion protection as needed for durability .
- **Assembly:** Attach any additional mounting plates or reinforcement elements to the bracket to support heavier loads or junction boxes .
