This approach improves cooling efficiency and reduces the risk of overheating. **Slack Management:** Leave sufficient slack in cables to allow flexibility and movement without creating excessive loops or bends. Proper slack management prevents stress on the fibers and ensures long-term performance .

Avoid over-tightening to prevent crushing the fibers . **Cable Sleeves and Socks:** Protective sleeves, expandable wraps, or cable socks help prevent tangling and physical damage, especially in high-density installations .
