

Methods for testing network speed on core switches



Article Overview

Network speed on a core switch can be tested using a combination of host-based bandwidth tools, switch monitoring protocols, and stress testing techniques.

1. Host-Based Bandwidth Testing

The most reliable method is to test from a connected host rather than the switch itself. You can use tools like iperf, TTCP, or SolarWinds WAN Killer to generate traffic and measure throughput between devices connected to the core switch or access switches . This approach provides a real-world measurement of the effective bandwidth available.

2. Switch-Based Testing

Some switches support built-in testing features:

- IP SLA (Service Level Agreement): Cisco switches can perform IP SLA tests to measure latency, packet loss, and throughput by simulating traffic between endpoints .
- TTCP implementations: Certain Cisco devices have hidden TTCP commands to test line speed internally .
- Port statistics: Check interface counters for errors, collisions, and utilization to identify potential bottlenecks
