

Mobile fiber optic cable cannot connect to the router

If your mobile fiber optic cable is not responding, the issue is often due to physical damage, loose connections, or signal loss, which can be resolved through systematic inspection and testing.

Step 1: Inspect Physical Connections

Check both ends of the fiber optic cable for visible damage, sharp bends, or loose connectors. Ensure the cable is properly seated in the router and any media converters or transceivers. Even minor misalignment can prevent signal transmission .

Step 2: Clean Connectors

Fiber connectors are sensitive to dust, oil, or debris. Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to clean the connectors and end faces. Proper cleaning often restores connectivity without further intervention .

Step 3: Test Signal Strength

If physical inspection and cleaning do not resolve the issue, measure the signal strength using a power meter or OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer). Signal levels outside the typical range (-15 dBm to -30 dBm) indicate a problem with the cable or connection
