

New Zealand Cable Tray Installation and Construction

Cable tray installation in New Zealand involves careful planning, compliance with AS/NZS 3000 standards, proper material selection, precise mounting, and thorough inspection to ensure safety and maintainability.

Planning and Design

Before installation, plan the cable tray route based on the site layout, electrical design, and load requirements. Consider clearance, cable separation, and future expansion. Review approved shop drawings to confirm tray layout, length, and location in electrical rooms, plant rooms, or service corridors . Obtain client approval for designs, materials, and drawings before starting work .

Material Selection and Preparation

Choose the appropriate tray type: ladder trays for airflow and heavy loads, perforated trays for lighter loads, or solid-bottom trays for protection . Inspect all materials for damage or discrepancies and store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports to prevent moisture or sunlight damage . Ensure all tools and equipment comply with contract requirements.

Installation Steps

- Site Preparation: Inspect the workspace, install safety barriers, and coordinate with other trades to avoid interference
